2022 IASF ADJUSTMENTS - WORLDS ONLY

Due to the continuing effects of the Covid-19 pandemic. The following adjustments will be applicable at the 2022 Cheerleading Worlds for all Non-US teams.

Adjustment 1 - Roster adjustments:

Teams may increase the number of athletes to the max number allowed within their divisions. The IASF tumbling division allows up to 24 members. If a team received a bid with 18, they may increase to 24.

Adjustment 2 - Division changes:

Teams may *not* change the category in which they received their bid. Division changes from within the same category will be permitted.

Example:

A Large Coed team adjusting to a Small Coed is permitted.

A Coed team moving to All girl is not permitted-

Adjustment 3- IASF Worlds 50% Substitution Rule

The substitution rules and guidelines will not be enforced at the 2022 IASF Worlds. Gyms reserve the right to adjust rosters as necessary. This will not change the WORLDS Crossover rule. This will not change the IASF max number of males allowed on a COED team. All athletes must be members of their respective gyms/clubs and may not be from another.

2022 IASF ADJUSTMENTS - NON-US TEAMS AT THE DANCE WORLDS ONLY

Due to the continuing effects of the Covid-19. In addition to the IASF Mission Statement and Vision of the IASF. The following adjustments will be applicable at the **2022 DANCE Worlds for all Non US teams.**

Roster / Division/ Genre adjustments:

Teams are allowed to change categories based on size, (Large to Small) or composition (Coed to All girl). Teams must stay in the same genre of the original bid they received at their Bid qualifying event. This will not change the WORLDS Crossover rule. This will not change the IASF Age grid.
